

Appliqué directions using your Embroidery Machine.



Supplies Needed For This Project:

- Small fabric scraps to match your purse.
- Quilt Basting Spray or Sulky KK 2000 temporary adhesive spray.
- Embroidery Threads to Match your Fabrics

For ease in handling spray starch & iron your fabrics before sewing.

For the Applique. Cut a square of fabric 4" x 4". Mark the placement of the design on the bag, marking center of both vertical and horizontal.

Position a piece of tear away stabilizer into your hoop. Spray the sulky spray adhesive to the wrong side of the front bag piece. Position the bag to the stabilizer with right sides facing up to you and centered in the hoop matching your placement lines.




Note: All Fabrics face right sides up

Note: it is not necessary to change your thread each time the machine stops. The Stops are put in there so that you can trim the embroidery.

Thread your machine with your embroidery thread. Position the hoop onto the machine. Start your embroidery. After the machine stops (first stop) remove your hoop from the machine. ***Do Not Remove The embroidery from the hoop.*** Trim the appliqué close to the outside edge of the stitched outline (less than an 1/8" away). Place the hoop back onto the machine. Restart and let the machine complete the embroidery. You're all done.

How easy was That.
