
FOURTH OF JULY Table Runner By Debbie Quinn ©2012



You will need:

Fabric 1- Star Block Background Fabric - 1/4 of a yard

Fabric 2 - Red Fabric for center of block, sashing and binding - 1/2 yard

Fabric 3 - Corner blocks For sashing - 1 fat quarter

Fabric 4 - Borders & Star points - 1/2 yard

For Backing-you will need 1/2 yard of fabric and 1/2 yard of batting

From Fabric 1 -Star Block

Cut - One 3" x width of fabric- Cut into twelve 3" squares

Cut - One 3 1/8" x width of fabric - Cut out template B and cut twelve B center triangles. Mark the notches left and right

From Fabric Two - Center of block, sashing and binding

Cut - one 3" x 9" fabric strip - from this cut three 3" sqaures

Cut - one 8" x 20" rectangle. From this cut one 8" square and six 2" x 8" strips

For the Binding- Cut three 2 1/4" x width of fabric strips

From Fabric Three - Corner squares of sashing Cut two 2" x 8" strips

From Fabric Four-Borders, Star Points


Long border - cut two 3 1/2" x 35"

Side borders - cut two 3 1/2" x 11"

Cut - two 2.5"x width of fabric strips" and one 2.5"x 8". Fold each fabric in half with right sides together, and cut 24 of template C & D. Mark the notch of each piece before sewing.

You will also need thread to quilt your project as well as thread to match the binding.


All units are sewn right sides together Finished Block Will Be 7.5"



Step One:

Match notches and sew star points (C&D) to the center triangle (B). Make 12 units. Press seams towards the outside.


Make 12 Units



Unit A

Step Two

Sew a 3" square to the right side and the left side of Unit A,. Make six sets. Press seams towards center.





Finished Set

Step Three

Sew unit A to the left and the right side of one red 3" square. Make three sets. Press seams towards the outside.






Finished Set (Center)

Step Four

Sew each set together the following way. After sewing the block should measure 8". Square up if necessary.



Make three Blocks


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Sashing

Sew the 2" x 8" strips (fabric 3) right sides together to the left and right side of the 8" square (fabric two).





Sew a 2" x 8" sashing strip (fabric two) to the right side and the left side of two blocks.

Press seams towards outside edges.



Sew a sashing strip with corner square to the top and the bottom of two blocks.

Press Seams towards center.






Make two

Sew a 2" x 8" (fabric two) sashing strip to the top and the bottom of the third block.


Press seams towards outside edges.





Make one

Sew each set right sides together



Sew 3 1/2" x 11" borders to the right and the left side of the table runner. Press seams towards border.
Then sew the 3 1/2" x 35" borders to the top and the bottom. Press seams towards border.
